Introduction & Mandate

In response to recent major changes to University policies, including the Voluntary Withdrawal, GPA Calculation, Repeated Course, Respectful Work & Learning Environment (RWLE), and Sexual Assault Policies, the University Policies Working Group (UPWG) was introduced to UMSU Council in October 2017.

Moving forward, the purpose of re-striking the UPWG behavioural working group is to continue student participation in major policy decisions, and increase engagement among students regarding important behavioral policies and procedures that affect them directly.

The working group's mandate is: "to advise the UMSU Council and UMSU Executives how to best advocate for changes to University Policies (UMSU Council Motion 0374)."

Working Group Structure:

The structure of the working group is open to all Undergraduate students. All UMSU members will be granted voting right and each Faculty Association will be asked to send at least one delegate to each meeting in order to ensure proper representation of all students' interests.

Composition:

- UMSU Vice-President Advocacy – Chair
- UMSU Vice President Student Services– Ex officio
- Senior Stick or designate from each faculty association
- Any interested UMSU member

Responsibilities:

- Review recommendations and final report of 2017/18 UPWG behavioural working group to ensure recommendations fit our campus and its community based on internal needs and issues
