

UM Run Club Constitution

Article 1: Name

The name of the student group shall be UM Run Club, also known as UMRun.

Article 2: Purpose of Club

UMRun exists to bring together students interested in recreational running, to organize regular group runs for the running community, and help encourage both physical and mental well-being.

Article 3: Membership

Membership is open to any undergraduate or graduate student of the University of Manitoba.

Memberships for the club last for a full academic year, September to August.

Article 4: Compliance with UMSU and UMSU Clubs Policies and Procedures

UMRun will follow all bylaws, policies, and procedures of the University of Manitoba Students' Union (UMSU) especially those found in the UMSU Student Clubs Policies and Procedures document.

Article 5: Executive Officers and Duties

The following are the Executive Officers of UMRun, along with their duties:

President

1. a) Attend all meetings of UMRun
2. b) Act as a signing authority for UMRun
3. c) Be the contact person for UMSU
4. d) Act as Chair for meetings if no other Chair has been appointed

Article 6: Executive Elections and Terms of Office

UMRun will not hold annual elections. When the current group leader is stepping down from the position, they can suggest new potential group leaders and the group as a whole will reach an agreement on the next group leader(s).

Article 7: Meetings

Group meetings addressing any important information will occur at the beginning of a running session. Group members will be notified a week in advance of any important information that will be discussed at the next run.

Article 8: Amendments to the Constitution

The proposed changes must be made available to all members of the club at least two weeks before the meeting, and require the support of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the members present and voting at the meeting.

A copy of the amended constitution must be submitted to UMSU within two weeks of the meeting via the UMSU UMRun portal.
