Nearu Martial Arts Club

**ARTICLE I:** Nearu Martial Art

The name of this organization is the Nearu Martial Art Club.

**ARTICLE II:** Purpose

Section 1: The premise of the club is set upon teaching students the physical and mental aspects of self-

defense via physical and breathing exercises that tend to increase physical fitness and confidence

respectively.

**ARTICLE III:** Membership

Section 1: Membership of the club shall be inclusive of all students, faculty and staff of the University of

Manitoba. Further, in hopes of sharing our knowledge with as many as we can, those keen on joining will

be regarded public members. Active membership is bound by a fee of \$30 for 12 sessions a month or \$4

per class. .

Section 2: Part of the policy of the club at the University of Manitoba that membership and membership

privileges are open to all enthusiasts without regard to race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin,

marital status, sexual orientation, age, disability, veteran status, or any other classification protected by

law, so that all members of the community are treated at all times with dignity and respect.

**ARTICLE IV:** Officers

Section 1: The officers shall consist of a President, Vice President and Treasurer. The officers shall be

responsible for all administrative duties of the Club.

Section 2: The President shall have the power to establish and maintain operation procedures of the club,

call meetings, and answer for all actions of the other officers. The President shall be able to vote in all

decisions affecting the club, as well as sign and approve club registration forms and budget requisitions

on behalf of the club, as the primary signing officer.

Section 3: The Vice President shall assist the President with all administrative duties and assume those

duties in the absence of the President. The VP shall receive and distribute the club funds upon

authorization of the President, in accordance with the financial rules and regulations of the University, as

well as the University of Manitoba's Student Union. The VP will also aid in the coordination of

fundraising activities. Upon the President's authorization, the VP shall be able to sign registration forms

and budget requisition forms, on behalf of the club, as the secondary signing officer.

Section 4: The Vice President of Communications shall assist the President with all administrative duties

and assume those duties in the absence of the President and VP Finance. The VP Communications shall

send/transmit all official club correspondences, and coordinate preparation and distribution of club flyers,

handouts and publications. The VP Communications will also aid in the coordination of fundraising

activities. Upon the President's authorization, the VP Communications, as the Club's booking officer,

shall be able to sign on behalf of the club, should the Club require to book event space on the University

grounds.

Section 5: Exceeding such appointed positions, the Nearu Martial Arts Club is governed by the belt

ranking and with placing the growth of each student as its cornerstone.

**ARTICLE V:** Funding

Section 1: The only fees members are responsible for are the gees, belts and monthly or per class

memberships fee.

Section 2: The club shall, as it deems necessary, undertake fundraisers for its own purposes. All

fundraising shall be conducted in accordance with UMSU's policies.

**ARTICLE VI:** Jurisdiction

Section 1: The club is subject, as a recognized and registered student organization, to the rules,

regulations, and policies of the University of Manitoba. The rules, regulations, and policies of the

university shall hold precedence over any and all rules, regulations, and policies applying to the Club,

including those of martial art organizations with which the Club is affiliated.
