New Updates

- Pre Budget-Submission

- We are currently working on our Pre-budget submission to the university to request additional funding in certain areas
- So far, we have started consultation with university departments such as the Student Counselling center, as well as security services and others, to ensure that we understand where funding can be properly contributed.
 - We want to make sure that we don't just ask for funding without proper understanding of where that funding goes
- I sat in on the Budget committee meeting and made sure to note my concern that they seem to be looking at the university as a business. Our pre-budget submission should be an accurate representation of where we need funding to go in order to ensure that this does not continue.
- UMSU general election CRO Selected
 - Selections committee met, and Thomas Tran has been selected as our CRO for this upcoming UMSU general election. This will need to be ratified by the board; however, the selection has been made.
- Direct Trade certification
 - After months of waiting for a response, we learned that the university cannot make their services fair trade, as there are complications with Aramark. However, I have connected with Aramark to ensure that they start the process of looking at direct trade certification.
- MHWG
 - The mental health working group will be looking to create a list of recommendations for UMSU and the administration to work on for the next year. This will help with transitioning the next UMSU team and ensuring that people feel properly supported.
- Operations and maintenance (formerly physical plant)
 - I had a meeting with Steve Cumpsty, the head of the department, and brought up the issues that student associations have been having. He seemed extremely receptive and ready to support us.
 - o I told him that wait times need to be adressed, and that there is a lack of respect.
 - He told me that if anyone notes any issues, that they should tell him directly. If you hear anything, please let me know.
 - We also talked about snow clearing across campus. He told me that he would look into that as well. Looking to increase the amount of clearing that is done.
- Dietetics program issue
 - Waiting on a response from Minister Reyes and President Benarroch. We sent a letter asking for support on the issue after meeting with students from NECO, and we are looking to have the issue solved as soon as possible.
- ISAP
