Continuing Updates

International student healthcare

Since the last BOD meeting, there has been a provincial cabinet shuffle. Hon. Jon Reyes is now the Minister of Immigration and Labour, while Hon. Sarah Guillemard (MLA for Fort Richmond) is the new Minister of Advanced Education and Training. Hon. Audrey Gordon remains the Minister of Health. Our advocacy will continue to the offices of the Minister of Advanced Education, Minister of Health, and now we will also extend our efforts to Hon. Jon Reyes portfolio of Immigration. We are hoping to meet with Minister Guillemard soon to discuss student issues, international student healthcare being one of them.

On February 10th, 2023, Jaron and I will be meeting with the CEO of Shared Health to discuss international student healthcare coverage.

They will be based on the 231 Calls for Justice outlined in "Reclaiming Power and Place: The Final Report of the National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls".
