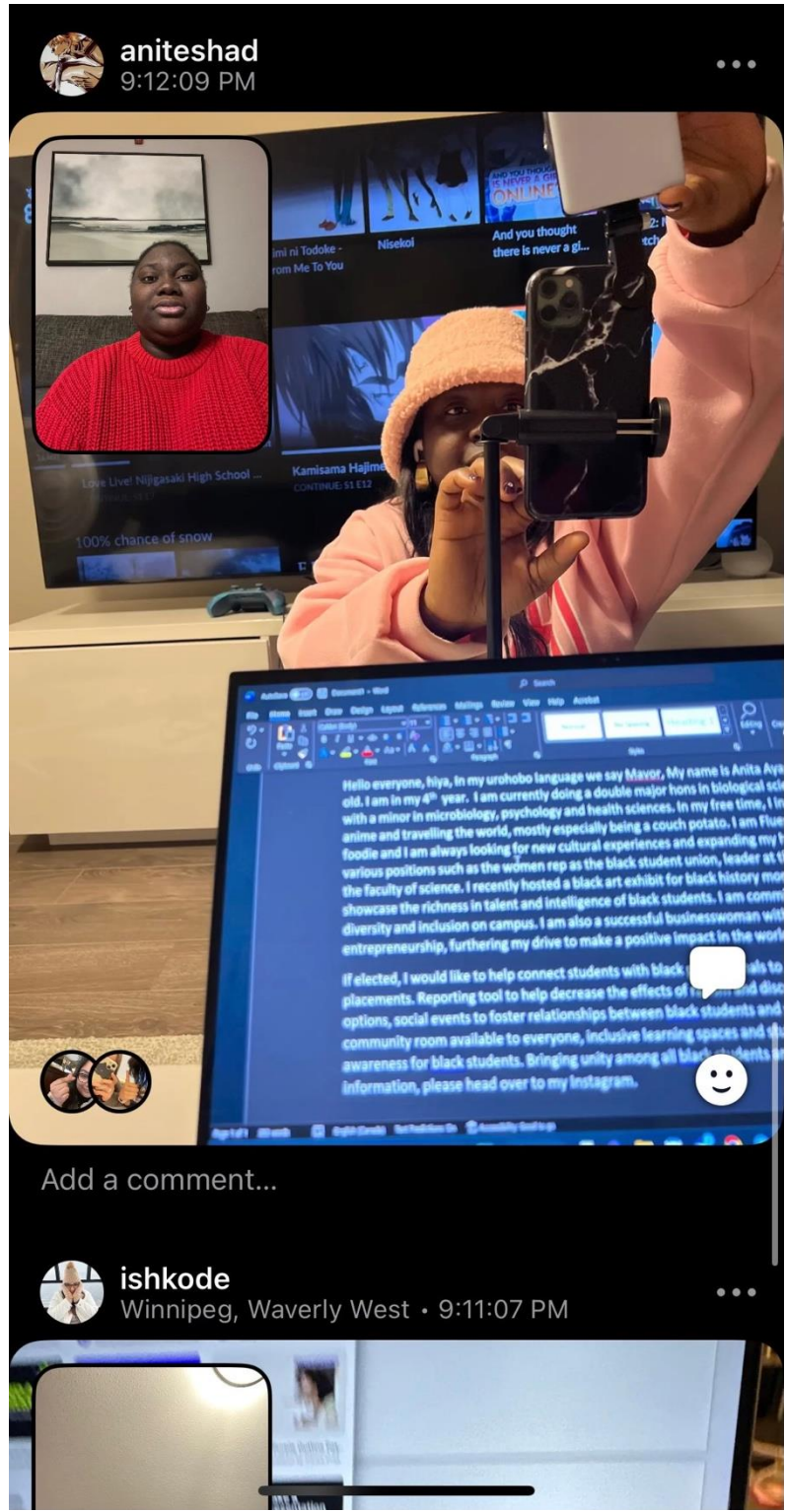

I know that there is sufficient time to close the laptop screen quickly, which would have been the correct action.

I can tell with certainty that this is both your candidate video transcript on the screen, as well as the outfit and setting you had in your first submission of the candidate video.

Everyone was warned multiple times regarding pre-campaigning both written and verbally.

If you wish to appeal this ruling you must do so through the Judicial Board with the appeal form provided on the UMSU elections website under Candidate Resources. Please note, only the party of the complaint can place an appeal.
