#HalfYourCSG CASA campaign

- The campaign emphasizes CASA's ask in Budget 2023 of permanently maintaining the current funding levels for Canada Student Grants, effectively doubling grant maximums for students across Canada.

- The Manitoba Immigration Advisory Council (council, co-chaired by the Minister of Advanced Education, Skills and Immigration and Dr. Lloyd Axworthy, reviews immigration in Manitoba, from promotion to retention of newcomers. It has provided clear recommendations and concrete actions to the Manitoba government including strengthening the Canada-Manitoba Immigration Agreement.) has released its final report and within it came this piece: "the council would like Manutoba to revisit the contingencies for international student healthcare coverage."
- Advocacy wins! The announcement of this suggestion within the official IAC report to the premier and province and is incredibly exciting , and we hope it is the first step in seeing major change for international students in Manitoba
