Businesses

Residence councils

Budget

The draft budget has gone through the Executive committee, Finance committee, and the Endowment fund for approval. The BOT adjusted their contribution to also index to CPI the same that the rest of UMSU fees do, leading to a \$25k larger contribution for student services this budget cycle.
