While I understand your written response Justin, all candidates were told that it was required to archive any posts that were on their feed that included other candidates for the remainder of the elections' period. This was stated in multiple Daily Campaign Meetings and candidates were encouraged to ask for clarification if they were unsure if a post needed to be archived.

If you wish to appeal this ruling you must do so through the Judicial Board with the appeal form provided on the UMSU elections website under Candidate Resources. Please note, only the party of the complaint can place an appeal.
