New Updates

Period Product Project

 I've reached out to several faculties about implementing dispensers and free period products in their buildings. There's been some interest and I will be meeting with Faculty Deans over the summer as well as the office of Sustainability on how we can make sure that this project is sustainable, and it does not just stop at a pilot project.

Take Back the Night

 - Access to therapists through the University or MyStudentWellBeing
 - o Resource centres and safe spaces on campus
 - Resources off campus
 - Accessibility resources
